Blairmont

Large, very red, with white crunchy flesh.
Ripens in September.

Fuji

Gourmet eating apple, developed in Japan. Medium-sized fruit, red over yellows striping. Firm, crunchy with spicy sweet flavor. Good for eating fresh or baking. Vigorous, bushy tree.
Ripens in October.

Gala Gala

New generation of red Gala sports with redder form than the popular Gala.
Very sweet and crisp. Stores well.
Ripens early to late August.

Kim Rome

Large, greenish apple with red blush. Semi-tart.
Ripens mid-September.

King David

Medium, pale green apple overlaid with dark red. Crisp, spicy, juicy yellow flesh.
Stores well. Great for eating, applesauce and baking.
Resistant to fire blight. Ripens late October to early November

Pink Lady

Golden Delicious x Lady Williams cross, originating in Australia, great cultivar for Southeast.
Pink blush over yellow, thin-skinned. Sweet-tart flesh resists browning when cut. Keeps well.
Vigorous tree with distinctive large leaves.
Ripens late October.

Pristine

1994 release from Purdue-Rutgers-Illinois breeding program.
Glossy lemon-yellow skin over sweet smooth flesh.
Productive, early-bearing.
Ripens mid-to-late July, before other disease-resistant cultivars.
