



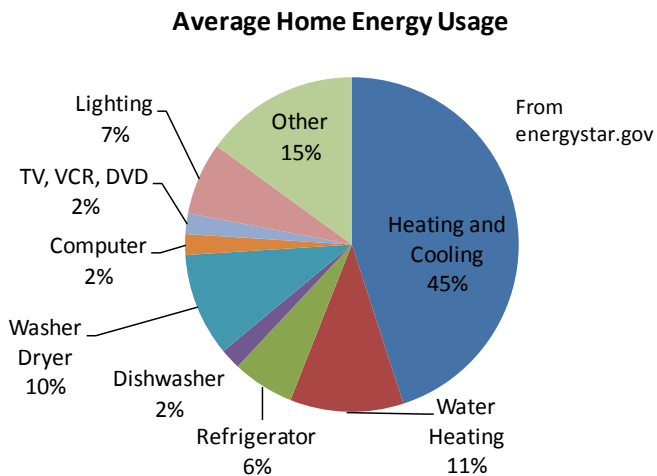

### Tips

- Changing habits can be the least expensive way to save energy.
- Don't let your heating and cooling get away - weatherization and duct sealing typically save 5 to 20%.
- Using less hot water makes for big savings
- Adding insulation to an older house is a must do
- Reducing energy usage of lighting, appliances, computers and entertainment systems will add up to important savings
- Bigger projects like new furnace or hot water heater, solar, geothermal and photovoltaic cost more initially but pay off in the long run.
